

The Institute of Mathematics, Chair for Mathematics in the Sciences, at the University of Würzburg is seeking applications for a post-doctoral position as a

research associate.

Candidates should have a strong background in the calculus of variations or in partial differential equations and should be interested in applications in the sciences. The candidates should have a PhD degree in mathematics or a related subject. They should show the abilities of both independent research and teaching. International experience is desired.

The salary is based on the wage agreement of the civil service in TVL 13 (100%). For a first idea about the amount of the salary see, e.g., <http://oeffentlicher-dienst.info/tv-1/west/>. The appointment is initially for three years with possible extensions. The position is meant for qualifying as a professor, e.g., by achieving a habilitation. The starting date would be at your earliest convenience.

The position also includes teaching duties between five and ten (to be negotiated) hours per week during term times. At the beginning, teaching can be provided in English, but the candidate is expected to teach in German after a certain time (to be negotiated).

The University of Würzburg wishes to increase the share of women in areas where they are underrepresented, and strongly encourages women to apply. The University of Würzburg has an affirmative action policy for the disabled and especially encourages them to apply.
