The Department of Mathematics at the University of Fribourg, Switzerland, invites applications for one

PhD Position in Analysis/Geometry

starting on 15 February 2015, or as soon as possible thereafter, on a topic close to one of the following: geometric measure theory in the setting of metric spaces, metric geometry, sub-Riemannian geometry, aspects of geometric group theory such as isoperimetric problems in groups.

Advisor: Prof. Stefan Wenger

Duration of the position: 4 years

Candidates must have a M.Sc. degree in Mathematics and should have a solid background in analysis and/or geometry, ideally with exposure to a least one of the topics above. A good command of German or French or the willingness to learn one of the two languages within a short period of time is required.

The PhD position is a full-time position which comes with a competitive salary and a teaching assistantship. PhD students are integrated in the Swiss Doctoral Program of Mathematics, jointly offered with neighboring universities.

Applications should be sent by email to stefan.wenger@unifr.ch and should include a letter of motivation, a curriculum vitae, a list of courses taken in mathematics, and a description of the candidate's research interests. Moreover, two letters of recommendation should be mailed directly by the letter writers to the email address above. Deadline for applications is 10 January 2015. Late applications may be considered until the position is filled.
