

ANNOUNCEMENT OF PUBLIC SELECTION FOR N° 1 FIXED-TERM RESEARCHER
(Italian law 30 December 2010, n.240, art.24 par. 3 lett. a)

Description

The Scuola Normale Superiore announces a selection for the recruitment of one fixed-term researcher, under art. 24, par. 3, lett. a) of the Law 240/2010, engaged on the basis of a full time appointment for a three-year term and by the stipulation of a private-law employment contract, at Classe di Scienze Matematiche e Naturali, to carry out research activities, teaching activities, supplementary teaching activities and tutoring to students, in the academic field 01/A3 “Mathematical Analysis, Probability and Statistics” – academic discipline MAT/05 “Mathematical Analysis”.

Research programme: Partial Differential Equations - Supervisor: Prof. Andrea Malchiodi

Research activities: The selected candidate is expected to undertake research activities on topics included in the academic disciplines MAT/05 (Mathematical Analysis), concerning the program described above, in particular concerning problems from Calculus of Variations, Analysis on Manifolds and Lie groups, Stochastic Processes.

The researcher’s teaching activities, integrative teaching activities, supplementary teaching activities and tutoring to students will consist in giving lectures, training sessions and, if needed, in support activities to teaching according to the annual planning approved by the competent bodies of the Scuola Normale and of the Classe di Scienze matematiche e naturali.

Duration of the contract: 3 years.

Remuneration: the annual remuneration will be the same as the starting remuneration for confirmed researchers, corresponding to an annual gross compensation of € 34.898,06.

Application deadline: the application must be received by September 21st, 2015 at 11:59 p.m. at the Scuola Normale Superiore.

Requisites

Applications are invited from:

1. candidates who have completed a PhD in Mathematics or equivalent degree and have carried out at least two years (even non-consecutive) of post-doc research in universities or research institutions, within the indicated subject field;
- OR
2. candidates who have completed a Master’s degree in Mathematics, Physics or equivalent degree and have carried out at least five years (even non-consecutive) of post-graduation research in universities or research institutions, within the indicated subject field.

Candidates who have completed the aforementioned degrees abroad may also apply, if said degrees are recognized as equivalent to Italian degrees.

Additional competence and/or experience relevant to the choice of the researcher: knowledge of English language.

Applications cannot be invited from:

1. full or associate professors or researchers who are employed presently or have been employed previously with an open-ended contract;

2. candidates who have had fixed-term contracts as research fellow or researcher as provided in Arts. 22 and 24 of Italian Law 240/10 at the Scuola or at other Italian universities, whether public, private or online, or bodies under Par. 1 of Art. 22 of Italian Law 240/10 for a period which, including the intended duration of the current selection, exceeds a total of twelve years, even if not continuing;
3. candidates who have had fixed-term contracts as researcher as provided in art. 24 par. 3, lett. a) of the Law 240/2010 at the Scuola or at other Italian universities, whether public, private or online, for a period which, including the intended duration of the current selection, exceeds a total of five years, even if not continuing;
4. candidates who have any relationships of marriage, family relationships or affinity, up to the fourth degree, with professors belonging to the Classe di Scienze Matematiche e Naturali, or with the Director, the Secretary General, the members of the Board of Directors of the Scuola.

How to apply

Candidates with all the aforementioned requisites who wish to participate in the selection process must present the application form (model A) drawn up on plain paper, with original signature.

In the application form they can also indicate the names of max. 3 experts in the field that they will take care of contacting to ask for possible reference letters, which must be sent by the experts, preferably in pdf format, directly to the email address andrea.malchiodi@sns.it, by the deadline.

They also attach the followings to the application form:

- a) a curriculum vitae containing a detailed list of the qualifications and the complete scientific production;
- b) any document and qualification – included among the ones declared in the curriculum vitae – that the candidate intends to submit, with relative list;
- c) the publications – included among the ones declared in the curriculum vitae – that the candidate intends to submit, in the maximum number of 12 including the doctoral thesis;
- d) relative list of the aforementioned publications;
- e) a photocopy (non-authenticated) of a valid identification document.

The documents at the previous letters a), b) and d) must be also presented on CD or USB flash drive, in pdf format, while the publications indicated at the letter c) must be presented exclusively on CD or USB flash drive, in pdf format.

In order to submit the application and documentation listed above, candidates must use one of these options:

- candidates can present the application form and documentation directly, during office hours, to the “Servizio Archivio, Protocollo e Posta” [Documents Registry Office] of the Scuola Normale, located at Via del Castelletto, n. 11, 56126 Pisa (Italy) or at Palazzo Strozzi, Piazza Strozzi, 50123 Firenze (Italy);
- candidates can send the application form and documentation by mail or courier to the same address. In this case, it is recommendable to write on the envelope “researcher position in the academic field 01/A3 “Mathematical Analysis, Probability and Statistics” – academic discipline MAT/05 “Mathematical Analysis”;
- candidates can send the application form using the electronic mail only if they possess a certified electronic mail address (PEC - Posta Elettronica Certificata).
